THE EDITORIAL BOARD Dr. Shashi Tiwari Dr. Aparna Dhir Ms. Suruchi Sharma and General Secretary of WAVES said that WAVES's sharing dais with Delhi Sanskrit Academy highlights the support and attraction of masses for Vedic learning. Vedas speak about *Brahma-Vidya* and all knowledge. Through this conference we aim to find out the relation of Science and Spirituality in Vedas.

In his inaugural address, **Shri Sashi Kejriwal** discussed the historical relevance of Vedas. He said Indians should take pride for having Vedic knowledge. Now east should be quoted instead of west for valuable ideas. He referred Greek historian, Pythagoras theorem, and knowledge of pyramids to highlight importance of Vedic thought in his address. Chief Guest, **Dr. Ganesh Dutt Sharma** indicated that Vedic sages recognized natural sources of energy as deities like sun, fire, water, tree *Ashvatha* etc in various mantras such as 'सूर्य आत्मा जगतस्तस्थुषश्च', 'अग्निमीळे पुरोहितं यज्ञस्य देवमृत्विजम्'. According to him Science and Spirituality are co-related because without each other they are handicapped. 'Vedas are foundation of Indian *Vidya* and WAVES is working

for it continuously' said **Prof. Upendra Rao.** He elaborated that Vedas are result of our *sages, research and dedication.* Vedas are actual depositories of science. People generally refer Vedas as book of rituals whereas in Vedic mantras indications of Science and Spirituality go hand in hand. **Dr. Rohit Chauhan** narrated Vedic knowledge as the knowledge through which universal eternal truth is

reveled to us. **Prof. Ram Gopal** stated that Spirituality is always defended by science. **Mr. Prashant Bhardwaj** praised *WAVES as school of thoughts* and emphasized that Saraswati Sindhu Civilization is the oldest civilization of the world. He talked about various findings being carried out on Saraswati river near Yamuna Nagar, Yamanotri and Gangotri Glaciers. Delivering Keynote address, **Prof. S.R. Bhatt** emphasized that Indian spiritual knowledge is not contradictory to scientific concepts. Oneness of all is essence of spirituality. **Prof. Pushpendra Kumar**, Former, Head of the Sanskrit Department, University of Delhi commented अग्निचैं ब्रह्म, जलं वै ब्रह्म, अन्नं वै ब्रह्म are some Vedic references which have deep scientific meanings. **Shri Subhodh Kumar** in his address explained the importance of Vedas in abolishing the difference of rich and poor. If one study Vedas, Puranas, Smritis then there is no need to constitute

a constitution. Vedas narrate references on many modern subjects such as democracy, consumer protection, re-election, global happiness, family life, skill development, poverty elevation, leadership qualities, food sciences, competitive spirit, planning commission, renewable energy etc. Delivering presidential address, **Prof. Ram Karan Sharma** enlightened the audience with the Binary notation of *Maharishi Pingal*. Whole science talks about

- Prof. Om Vikas, Senior member, IEEE, Delhi & Former Director, IIITM, Gwalior—Pursuit of Innovation for Vedic Studies.
- Prof. Vijay K. Vaishnavi, Emeritus Professor, Computer, Georgia State University, USA—Raja Yoga in the Modern Scientific Context.
- Prof. Ram Gopal, Former Director, DRDO & President, Jodhpur Chapter, WAVES—Science And Spirituality For Holistic Development of S&T Personnel.

Dr. Rohit Chauhan stated that all sciences are driven by needs of a physical human-self. 'Spirituality' is the foundation for all advancements. All renowned contributors to mankind, including scientists, have been known to exhibit spiritual behavior. In some respect, every living being possesses spirituality-may be in a latent form. Science is objective, relating almost entirely with physical levels of human consciousness, while the spiritualists are in the higher levels of consciousness. Spirituality is subjective, relating with nonphysical aspects of life where science may now be consciously knocking at the doors for fresh ideas. Prof. Om Vikas stated that Knowledge is critical factor in accomplishing any task with excellence. Innovation is reflection of multidisciplinary frameworks of knowledge. Knowledge flows in both explicit and implicit forms. Western (Cartesian) logic has its own limitations. Further, cognitive studies look towards oriental systems of knowledge representation, reasoning, inference and interpretation.



Prof. Vijay K. Vaishnavi said that Raja yoga provides a systematic path for our spiritual growth and for realizing our true nature of divinity—Cosmic Consciousness

Prize winning researchers

(*Param Shiva*), symbolically represented by *Shiva Lingam*. He provided a brief review of Raja yoga along with that of yoga. **Prof. Ram Gopal** discussed about the goal of *Sarvjan hitay sarvjan sukhay* that can be achieved by implementing Vedic Traditions. Without spirituality one does not develop politeness, modesty and *Seva Bhava*. Value based management of science and spirituality needs to be brought with Indian concept of unity in diversity at global level.

#### IMPACT OF INDIAN PHILOSOPHY 9th May, 2015

Delhi Sanskrit Academy, Delhi

A symposium on 'Impact of Indian Philosophy' was organized by WAVES, in association with Delhi Sanskrit Academy, at Seminar Room, Delhi Sanskrit Academy. Dr. Yvette C. Rosser, Author and Philosopher, University of Texas, Austin, USA and Prof. Sunita Singh Sengupta, Faculty from Management Studies, Delhi University and Honorary Convener, ISOL Foundation were the invited speakers. Dr. Dharmendra Kumar Shastri, Secretary, Delhi Sanskrit Academy, Delhi was the *Saraswat Atithi*. Prof. Bhu Dev Sharma, Founder President, WAVES was the Chief Guest on this occasion. Prof. Usha Choudhuri, Former Professor, Sanskrit Department, University of Delhi chaired the program.

**Dr. Yvette C. Rosser** presenting her views on 'How Ancient India's Philosophies are Changing Modern America's Psychology- with reference to '*Nasadiya Sukta*' talked about great personalities of India who influenced the intellectuals of world. She mentioned Mahatma Gandhi, Rabindranath Tagore,Shri Aurobindo, Swami Vivekanand, Maharishi Yogi and many other saints of Indian land in this context. For over two centuries the West, and the US in particular, has been integrally influenced by ideas from India; beginning with the Transcendentalists, in the early nineteenth century, followed by the dynamic teacher Swami Vivekananda who took American by storm in 1863, and the Theosophical Society at the end of the century.

Then decades later came the realized monk Paramahansa Yogananda in the 1920's, whose Self-Realization Fellowship is still a vibrant force in the USA where by the late half of the twentieth century, societal changes had catalyzed the search for answers to vexing ontological and epistemological questions, which led millions of Americans to look for the meaning of existence from within the ancient traditions of India. Questioning is important way of learning and explanation in Vedic philosophy. She proclaimed that the concept of oneness plays significant role in Indian philosophy.

In his comments Prof. Bhu Dev Sharma admired the speaker for depth of thoughts. He talked about the Brahmins of Boston and referred the book 'Expe*riences'* authored by Arnold for deep psychological studies. He mentioned Steve

Jobs, CEO of Apple who spent seven months in Nanital for spiritual insights. **Shri Subodh Kumar** said many Americans believe in rebirth. Ms. Deepti Gupta wanted to know 'who inspires the speaker for Indian culture'. Dr. Manoj Sharma asked 'Is the term Dharma synonym to Hinduism?' The speaker said Dharma incorporates Hinduism which is essence, idea, concept and natural law. Dharma is a big word. It is not a matter to believe because it exists eternally.

**Prof. Sunita Singh Sengupta** spoke about 'Vedantic Foundations of Education as Envisaged by Swami Vivekananda'. She talked about Swami Vivekananda's philosophy and his efforts towards integration. *Ashtavkra gita* illustrates important thoughts of Hinduism and philosophy of life. Spiritual stimulation and strong character was the aim of ancient Indian education. True nature lies in one's own self, in the sense of

righteousness, she emphasized giving references.

Dr. Dharmendra Kumar Shastri talked about the sameness of all religious thoughts. Morals for human beings are universal i.e. 'sarvabhaum'.

He explained the

unity of *kaarana* and *kaarya* in reference to creation. **Dr. Ganesh Dutt Sharma** expressed pride that India is foremost in giving philosophy and culture to world through Vedas and other scriptures. **Shri Vidyasagar Verma** stated relevance of ancient Indian wisdom in modern world. In her presidential address, **Prof. Usha Choudhuri** pointed out the vision of Vedic Seers on Dharma. It should be understood as a sustaining and developing aspect which is eternal. Vedas say that this world is *Dvandvatmak Jagat* because here all objects have two phases such as day-night, birth-death, *sat-asat* etc.

Only Brahman is ultimate consciousness and thus above duality. In India we have many philosophies and we respect opposite views as well.

#### **VEDIC YOGA**

#### 24th November, 2015 Human Advancement Institute, New Delhi

In association with Human Advancement Institute, WAVES has conducted a lecture on "Vedic Yoga", where Padma Bhushan Dr. David Frawley (Vedacharya Vamadeva Shastri), Vedic Scholar from USA was the key speaker and Prof. Bhu Dev Sharma, Renowned Mathematician & Founder President-WAVES was the chairman, while a number of eminent scholars and students were present as discussants. While introducing the speaker Dr. Shashi Tiwari quoted Sri Aurobindo's statement that Vedas reveal to those who has higher spiritual knowledge.

Dr. Frawley in his lecture explained that the deeper study of Vedas expose historical, cultural, scientific, spiritual and philosophical aspects of Vedic knowledge. In general the term 'yoga' means 'asana', whereas in real sense Yoga-Vidya is applications such as bhakti-yoga, gyan-yoga, Karamyoga. 'Asana' is only one stage of yoga. 'Om' or

'Pranav' is the base of mantra-yoga. It is vibratory state of yoga. Term 'yoga' mentioned is in Upanishads. The first six shlokas of chapter-II of Shvetashvatara Upanishad deal with this subject. All Upanishads talk about 'Guhya Vidya' which is actually а spiritual knowledge. Shrimad-

bhagvadgita is the main book on Yoga-philosophy. Mokshadharam-parva of Mahabharata too narrates about the principles of Yoga.

We should not look at Vedic deities according to Puranic concepts as Vedic deities are actually forces of nature which can be elaborated in context of the Yoga. Through them Vedic seers explained universal symbolism in a poetic way. One should always understand the deep rooted inner meanings of Vedic deities, such as 'Sun' is a symbol of universal divine light or can be explained as Prana or Atma. 'Indra' can be understood as ruling power which is Ishwar, Atma, Prana, Aayush. Agni is 'अंगुष्ठमात्र प्राण' *i.e.*, 'जीवात्मा', वाक्, प्राण, शरीर, आत्मा are tools of Yoga. By quoting ''शतं शतानि पुरुष: समेनाष्ट्रौ शता...प्राणिति चापापानिति'', (Shatapatha Brahamana 12.3.2.8) he explained philosophy of Prana-Tattva. "We can experience ourselves as energy", by saying this Dr. Frawley concluded his talk.

In his comments Prof. Upendra Rao, Chairman, Special Centre of Sanskrit Studies, JNU, Delhi said yoga is ancient; we all should have proud on our ancient spiritual knowledge. Dr. Frawley gives the panoramic view of the Vedic Yoga through his lecture, said Dr. Somdutt Dixit. Dr. Chand Bhardwaj appreciated the connection of Vedic knowledge to scientific aspect of meditation. Many queries were raised. Prof. S.P. Narang asked about postures of Yoga. Prof. Lallan Prasad considered rituals as Yoga.

To explain or to teach Vedic spirituality one need practice of Ayurveda. Dr. R.S. Kaushal discussed plurality

of meanings in Vedas. In his presidential address, Prof. Bhu Dev Sharma emphasized on the right application of rituals and congratulates Dr. David Frawley for his outstanding lecture. Mr. I.D. Kansal presented a vote of thanks.

#### RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN AYURVEDA AND JYOTISH 5th January, 2016 Human Advancement Institute, Delhi

On this occasion, Dr. Jeffrey Armstrong 'Kavindra Rishi', Director, Vedic Academy of Science & Arts (VASA), Vancouver, Canada was the key speaker. Prof. Bhu Dev Sharma, Renowned Mathematician & Founder President-WAVES was the chairman. Dr. S.C. Goswami, a well known thinker and a former Prof. of Chemistry was present in the program as main discussant with other scholars and students. Dr. Shashi Tiwari introduced the speaker. She said that Dr. Armstrong is a relationship expert, philosopher, practitioner of Yoga and teacher of the Vedas, Ayurveda, and Jyotish for over 40 years. His deepest wish is to receive benefit for humanity from the great library of Vedic knowledge. Jeffrey has a clear perspective of the issues facing the world and the role Vedic knowledge can help in some of the problems of human sufferings worldwide. Dr. Armstrong is an award-winning poet and best-selling author of numerous books including spiritual teachings.

At the outset, Dr. Jeffery mentioned that there are nearly 2 million practicing yogis in the world today. He said that the knowledge of Ayurveda moved eastward to China and they picked it up.

Dr. Jeffery explained the interconnected nature of all that exists. He said that in this universe all is based on intelligence. Nothing is random. There is a meaning behind every birth on this earth. Your body, your mother, your father all are based on your deeds i.e. Karma. Life i.e. Jivana is result of your Karma.Dr. Armstrong said that body is simply a carrier, made of five elements, i.e., agni, prithvi, vayu, jal and aakash. It should be in perfect shape to lead life up to its goal Moksha. For that Ayurveda helps. It studies type's of human body. There are three types of body due to prominence of three Gunas: Vata, pitta and Kapha. The effect of Jyotish moves from life to life. One has to balance one's life with nature. He said that 98% of the body type can be predicted by Jyotish. The punch line is to sell Ayurveda to the world as market is responding to it. He said that precise genetic code can be determined by Jyotish. He said that Indian culture is quickly recovering from colonization and the whole world is getting attracted to this.

Jyotish is a study of *graha i.e.* planets. A *Graha is* powerful as that holds one's life and casts its effect on it. If one can know about one's main *graha* and its relationship with oneself through Jyotish and side by side can know one's body type through Ayurveda, this can do wonders for the health as well as for mental enhancement and peace. These knowledge are helpful to understand the cause (*karana*) and inner mind (*antah karana*). Dr Jeffery praised Indian wisdom of medicine

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where preventive drugs are given importance. Modern medicine works mostly on symptoms of diseases as curatives. Removing one symptom and creating another is Allopathy. In Vedic traditions mankind is considered a mind-kind so they related body with mind and intellect to study a human being. Covering all the basics of body types, and their signs, he explained beautifully how to know ones identify, body type, personality and character.

Dr. S.C Goswami described the talk as highly inspiring. He said that we are all interconnected with each other at the guantum level. He described Advaita Vedanta as the crown iewel of all philosophies. Dr.Goswami remarked that it is the field theory behind the medicine rather than the chemistry which works. He said that yoga is a part of ancient knowledge based on practical and several integrated disciplines. We all should have pride on our ancient knowledge. He asked: How is it that Sun in Vedic tradition of Jyotish is considered one of the nine grahas, a planet while it is in fact a star? Dr. Jeffery answered that in Jyotish graha is the Sanskrit word meaning a heavenly body, not a mere planet. The confusion arises because of inappropriate translation of 'graha' as a planet. Dr. Chand Bhardwaj, Dr. R.S. Kaushal, and Dr. Sarojini Pitam also commented on the lecture. At request, from the Chair, Dr. Armstrong recited a self composed poem.

In his presidential address, **Prof. Bhu Dev Sharma** mentioned about the roots of *Ayurveda* in *Atharvaveda*, where some ailments are attributed to past life and *karma*. This area, he said, seems to point to what are in the present system termed as genetic diseases. In respect of Jyotish he suggested to Dr. Armstrong to explore the *Vedic-Jyotish* of Lagadh, which is most ancient of work on Jyotish and is available. Further, he mentioned that based on astrological/ astronomical soft ware, birth, and other events, for example of Lord Rama, have been dated. He referred to some publications in that direction available with a friend who was present in the audience. The talk was greatly appreciated.

On the occasion of this special program, Dr. Koenraad Elst, Orientalist, Philosopher & Author of Hindu Religion from



Belgium was the keyspeaker. Prof. Bhu Dev Sharma, renowned mathematician was the chairman of the session. After invocation Dr. Asha Lata Pandey introduced the speaker and the guests to the audience.

Dr. Koenraad Elst said Buddhism is generally used as a weapon against Hinduism now-a-days to show their differences. Some authors project as if Hinduism is a problem while Buddhism is a solution. But all this is not true when we go through the principals of Buddhism in length. Dr. Elst emphasized that Hinduism is a much larger term. As Arya-Samaj, Ramkrishana- mission are Hindus so as Buddhists. Vedic Sanskrit is the language of rishis. Vedic traditions are the foundation of all thoughts developed in India. All the vernacular languages of Indians are sisters, daughters and nieces of Sanskrit language. Vedic traditions are centre of most of the Hindus practices. Vedic Culture must be considered as the backbone of Indian Wisdom. Dr. Elst opined that to him Buddhism is not a reaction or revolt to Vedic tradition. Vedic tradition is originated in Saraswati basin in remote past. Buddhism and Jainism were originated after Upanishads. Buddha did not believe in caste system. He laid stress on Yoga and meditation. He used to give political advice to many contemporary kings. He was never a social reformer. He preached ethics and renunciation. Buddha insisted that desires cannot be fulfilled so be peaceful, nonviolent and calm and never waist valuable time in human

life. It can be said that his preaching was very much on Vedic lines. He advised his followers that all religious traditions must be preserved. He used *Dharma* and *Karma* terms in some different meanings which should be understood in right



perspective. Prof. Bhu Dev Sharma praised the talk before inviting comments. Prof. Lallan Prasad referred to Jatak studies of Buddhism in reference to Buddhist law of Karma. Whatever you do in this life is transferred to another life. Prof. S.P. Narang said that Buddhism, Jainism and Hinduism all are correlated. Dr. R.S. Kaushal observed that philosophical contribution of Buddhism was not discussed today while it is quite significant. Dr. Chand Bhardwaj asked how these values can be taught to youngsters. Oct., 2015. The inaugural presentation was made by Dr. R.L. Kasyap, Director of Sri Kapali Sastry Institute of Vedic Culture. He explained the importance of Yajurveda and the interpretations made by Sri Aurobindo to reach common people in its understanding the

relevance of the Veda. Dr. C.L. Prabhakar, gave a Preamble- note of the seminar and explained the studies done on Yajurveda hitherto.

Distinguished scholars in the field were the source persons who discussed various aspects of Sukla and Krishna Yajurveda.

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#### वेव्ज़ की हरिद्वार शाखा

को दो भागों में विभक्त कर सकते हैं–1. पंच मुख्य प्राण– प्राण, अपान, व्यान, समान, उदान। २. पंच गौण प्राण–नाग, कूर्म, कृकल, देवदत्त, धनंजय। वेदों में प्राण विज्ञान एवं उसकी उपयोगिता को स्पष्ट करते हुए विद्वान वक्ता ने कहा कि यजुर्वेदीय मंत्र में रूद्राः शब्द से प्राण, अपान, व्यान, उदान, समान, नाग, कूर्म, कृकल, देवदत्त, धनंजय नामक दश प्राण एवं ग्यारहवाँ जीव–शतपथ ब्राह्मण 14, 6, 9, 4–6। योगसाधक जब नित्य सुख स्वरूप मोक्ष की प्राप्ति के लिए योगयज्ञ का विस्तार करता है तो वसन्तादि उत्तम ऋतूएं योगयज्ञ के विस्तार में सहायक हो समिधा का कार्य करती हैं–यजूर्वेद 2,5। ऋग्वेदीय ऋचा में प्रयुक्त रुद्रा पद द्वारा एकादश प्राणों का ग्रहण किया गया है। प्राणों का नियमित व्यापार करते रहने से ही स्थुल शरीर स्वस्थ रह सकता है। योगविद्या के अन्तर्गत प्राणायाम का महत्व स्वीकार करते हुए कहा कि प्राणायाम का अभ्यास विधिपूर्वक करने से अनेक लाभ होते हैं। परन्तू बिना सीखे अयुक्त विधियों से किया गया प्राणायाम अनेक रोगों का जनक होता है। उन्होंने मनोमयकोश का स्वरूप एवं मन का वेदोक्त विवेचन करते हुए श्रोताओं को संयम तथा मनोनिग्रह का महत्व स्पष्ट किया। ऋग्वेद के पुरुषसूक्त में शरीर और ब्रह्माण्ड की एकता दिखाते हए कहा गया है कि इस शरीर रूपी पिण्ड में मन चन्द्रमा रूप है–चन्द्रमा मनसो जातश्चक्षोः सूर्यो अजायत।। (ऋ. 10, 90, 13, यज्. 31, 12)
