ACTIVITIES AT DELHI

THE ORIGINS OF YOGA REVISITED

3rd March, 2018 Human Advancement Institute (HAI), New Delhi

WAVES and HAI organised a lecture program at HAI, where Dr. Koenraad Elst, Orientalist, Philosopher and Author of Hindu Religion from Belgium was the key speaker. The topic of his talk was '*The origins of Yoga Revisited*'. Prof. Bhu Dev Sharma, Renowned Mathematician chaired the program. Prof. Shashi Tiwari introduced the learned speaker and guests. The program started with the *Sarasvativandana* done by Dr. Supriya Sanju, member, WAVES.

Dr. Koenraad Elst started his lecture with the Genesis of Yoga. He said Yogic practice is claimed very old, as in the Harappan age we find *Pashûpati* seal, that is the oldest example of yogic postures. He said Yoga is *Samâdhī*, total meditation. It is a road to God. He added few references from *Brâhmana*s and *Upanishads*. *Shatpatha Brâhmana*, *Kaustâki Brâhmana*, and *Kathopanishad* are few Vedic texts where Yoga is mention as a practice to seek liberation from rebirth. He discussed chronological order of old scriptures to highlight the significance of Yoga and guoted views of



some western scholars who did comparison of Hinduism and Buddhism to know the origin of Yoga. Buddha's main posture is indeed Yoga-posture, Being historian he assumed that Vedas are part of history.

Yoga is present in Vedas. One can see various hymns of Vedas like 1.164, ''द्वा सुपर्णा सयुजा सखाया समानं वृक्षं परिषस्वजाते'' etc as examples. In Vedas, Yoga is not in the sense of yogic exercises but it actually indicates the sense of actual union. One can find Yoga's very first definition in *Kathopanishad* where union of five senses with mind is stated. When self is integrated with the supreme it is Yoga. Yoga teaches that one has to first free himself from all religious beliefs then only one can be a true Yogic. He quoted *Svâdhyâya* as the practice of Yoga. *Kaivalya* (केवल्य), is the ultimate goal of Yoga.

Prof. Lallan Prasad discussed the metaphysical nature of Yoga by mentioning *Bhakti-Yoga, Karam-Yoga* and *Gyan-Yoga* of *Srimadbhagavadgita*. Combination or the union of mind and senses is Yoga. He referred is book *Jatak-Kavya-Mala* from where he wrote few *Jatak* stories with the concept of Yoga. There are many common things in reference to Yoga in Hinduism, Jainism and Buddhism. **Shri Subhash Gogate** referred *Parmarthik*-Yoga and narrated *Ashtanga*-Yoga. He said one has to be master of eight stages of Yogaasanas. According to him Patanjali-Yoga-Darshan has been written twice one before Buddhism, and secondly after Buddhism. Yogasutras present knowledge about how to unite with

supreme entity as quoted in Taittiriyopanishad. Dr. Ganesh Dutt Sharma said each and every aspect of life needs union, and that is Yoga. In other words, it can be understand as union of relations, union of senses, union between mind and intellect, union between senses and mind, ultimately union between mind and soul which leads to union of soul and supreme. This is the ultimate goal of our life. In short, the practical knowledge is recognized as Yoga. Shri Y.K. Wadhwa referred two books entitled 'Vedo me yoga-vidya' and 'Sandhya se samadhi' to highlight the importance of Yoga in Vedas. He pointed out sixth chapter of Manusmriti where relevance of Prânâyâma is discussed vividly. In his presidential address, Prof. Bhu Dev Sharma praised learned speaker for his wide knowledge. He mentioned his observations on teaching Yoga and Hinduism to foreign students.

researcher, philosopher, thinker, writer, speaker and public intellectual on current affairs as they relate to civilizations, cross-cultural encounters, religion and science. Shri Rajiv Malhotra gave as

impressive talk about India's grand narratives and role of *Shruti* and *Smriti* texts in this narrative. He explained that every country has its grand narratives. Our ancient *Shastras* are important for us because they established our grand narratives since ancient times. Vedas are universal in contents. There may be many levels of narratives as Vedic *Ritam*, Post-Vedic *Yajna* and Puranic *Dharma* are conceptually the same. Our intellectual traditions are transmitted using three aspects *-Shastras*, practice or ritual, and institution or *parampara*. It is our *Shastras* that make our culture Vedic, and it is the strength of *Shastras* that helped our culture survive despite huge damage done over a very long time. *Shruti* is the foundation of our religion. Shri Malhotra said that we should be careful that in the name of new interpretations, we don't encourage wrong or subversive theories being developed by so-called modern thinkers.

Shri Ashok Pradhan agreed with the views of Shri Malhotra that distortions should be checked by us. The practical aspects of Vedic traditions should be emphasized to bring change in society. It

can be done through right education.

Prof. S.R. Bhatt appreciated the vision of Shri Malhotra. He said that our culture is wide and full of many possibilities. *Shruti* should not be interpreted according to one's influenced approach. It is time that we see ourselves with our own eyes. Vedas are foundation of Indian cultural values. A number of distinguished scholars and research students attended this program and took part in the discussion.

GEOGRAPHY OF BHARATA IN VEDIC LITERATURE

21st April, 2018 Bhartiya Vidya Bhavan, New Delhi



Book release by dignitaries

Special Lecture has been organised by WAVES-India at Bhartiya Vidya Bhavan. Shri Mrugendra Vinod, renowned Vedic scholar was the key-speaker. Dr. A. K. Mishra, Deputy Director, Ministry of Defence was the chief guest. The lecture was presided by Dr. Dharmendra Kumar Shastri, Head, Department of Sanskrit, Khalsa College, Delhi University.

Shri M. Vinod talked about some main Vedic texts which have reference about ancient geography. He said, 'Sarasvata Satra and Darshadvata Satra are two Vedic Rituals with many outstanding features. It is one of the rare instances where a particular location is prescribed for performance. Other Rituals from Agnihotra to Ashvamedha can be performed at any suitable location but these Rituals are to be performed only on the banks of River Sarasvati and River Drishadvati. The Sarasvata Satra is a moving Ritual performed with Vedi-on-wheels. It is started from the place called Vinashana where Sarasvati disappears in the desert. The process of

daily sacrifice is followed by throwing a stick upstream on the right or southern bank of Sarasvati. The whole Vedi or Ritual-altar is shifted to the new place. This shift amounts to a movement of 50 m/day or 18 km/year. The journey has to cross a river called Drishadvati. Later Vedic texts tell us that Drishadvati may not have water. This place of confluence is 8 Ashvin from Vinashana. This journey concludes at the place called Plaksha Prasravana. Total distance is 44 Ashvin. We here use our previous work in which we showed that Ashvin~=10 km. So the

distance from Vinashana to Plaksha Prasravana comes out to be ~440 km. The time taken will be ~22 years. Performers walk over to Karapachava on Yamuna River from Plaksha Prasravana after giving away their cows and other materials for their terminal ablution called Avabhrita Snana.

He explained further, 'Darshadvata Satra is another Ritual similar to Sarasvata Satra. It has a great deal more to tell

us about the geographical details of Drishadvati. We see places named Naitandhava Arma, Parinat Sthali, Prabhavya Arma and Tri-Plaksh-Avaharanam along Drishadvati. We

also note the detail of eastward shifting of Yamuna being documented by later Vedic texts.We have used the established multi-disciplinary studies of the dry bed of Sarasvati and Drishadvati as a base. We mapped the distances predicted by this Vedic literature on this known dry bed. We discovered remarkable places at the predicted distances for Vinashana and Plaksha-Prasravana of Sarasvati. We here present for the first time the direct discovery of Vedic geographical landmarks of Naitandhava Arma, Prabhavya Arma and Tri-Plaksh-Avaharanam. We have done 6 field visits to the entire region to substantiate our theoretical work. We also performed a Padayatra of Sarasvati like the Tirthayatra of Balarama as shown in epic of Mahabharata from 21st December 2017 to 5th January 2018'. Shri Vinod's lecture followed a lively discussion where some observations were added by scholars.

Chief Guest **Dr. A.K. Mishra** stated the importance of Dharma and Moksha among four *Purusharthas*. Due to its great effect Vedic or Indian culture reached to some other countries in that remote period. *Guptachar*-system is originally found in Vedas, he said.

Dr. Dharmendra Kumar Shastri focussed on the universality of Vedas in his presidential remarks. Vedas talk about all universe and total humanity. Vedic Verses are full

of deep knowledge. Only extra intelligent, seers can reveal them. Therefore, to understand the true meaning of mantras we should take words in their *Yaugika* usage. Veda cannot be studied by *Alpashruta*, he added. He appreciated the survey and deep study of Shatapatha Brahmana done by learned speaker.






